David and Stephen will be on hand throughout the day to talk about their work. At about 1.30 pm David will give a 30-minute talk on the rationale behind his work. In the afternoon we will have tea (kindly supplied by David) in David's garden, where we will be able to view some of his larger paintings and parts of three real mosaics.
